Glen Lake Community Library Disruptive behavior

The library strives to maintain a calm, safe atmosphere conducive to reading, studying, and use of library materials. Any behavior that disrupts such an atmosphere is considered inappropriate. Examples of such behavior include:

- Loud talking or conversation
- Abusive, threatening or offensive language
- Excessively loud audio or electronic equipment, including cell phones
- Running or rough play
- Inappropriate use of library furniture, equipment or materials
- Inappropriate consumption of food or beverages

Library staff will, at their discretion, restrict any behavior that is deemed inappropriate. While parents are expected to supervision their children, library staff will do so if needed to ensure that these guidelines are observed.

Patrons will be held responsible for damages to library collections, furniture, and facilities caused by disruptive or inappropriate behavior.
